# The 10YFP at Mid-term

*“The 10-year framework of programmes on sustainable consumption and production patterns should be reviewed at the end of five years to assess benefits, challenges and implementation”*

## 10YFP Progress 2012-2017

Timeline: 2012-2017

- Identify, replicate and scale up best practices
- Assess and improve performance to inform the planning of activities and allocation of funds
- **Report and demonstrate progress to show accountability towards all actors and donors**
- Communicate results to the wider public
- Mobilize political and financial support

## Independent External Review

Timeline: Q4 2017

- Review accomplishment of 10YFP objectives, and effectiveness of different approaches
- Review the operational effectiveness of the 10YFP structure
- Inform the development of the 10YFP five-year strategy 2018-2022
- Online survey to all 10YFP actors currently ongoing

## 10YFP Strategy 2018-2022

Timeline: Q4 2017 and Q1 2018

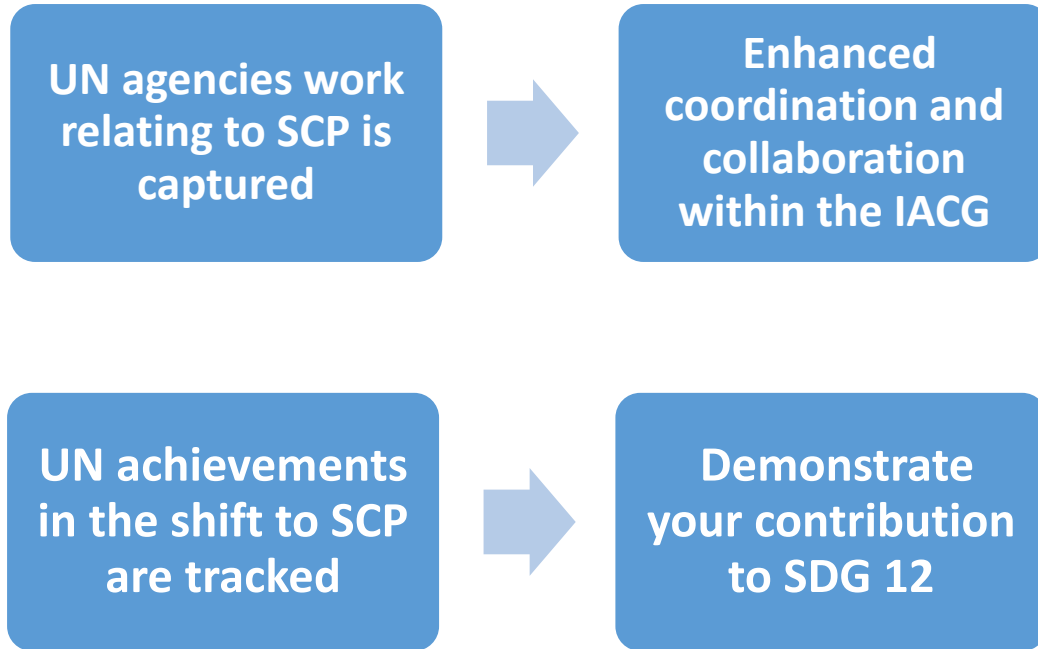
- Strategy task force launched on 1 November
- 15 member task force, with 1 representative per 10YFP group **UN-Habitat representing the IACG**
- Strategy development: November 2017 to March 2018

## Dissemination & visibility (HLPF 2018 & SDG 12)

Timeline: Q2 2018

- HLPF is the central platform for reviewing and following up on the 2030 agenda and SDGs
- At HLPF in 2018, SDG12 will be reviewed in depth
- Showcase the 10YFP as an implementation mechanism for SDG 12
- **Showcase progress & launch key initiatives**

# 10YFP Indicators of Success

## PRINCIPLES



# Objective

To guide and measure, in a participatory way, the collective impact and key milestones towards the global shift to SCP.

**The framework aims to support the 10YFP actors & other stakeholders working on SCP to:**

- I. **assess and improve performance** to inform the planning of activities and allocation of funds; and
- II. **report and demonstrate progress** to show accountability towards all actors and donors, communicate results to the wider public, and mobilise political and financial support.



Based on 10YFP objectives, functions and programmes, and aligns with: Rio +20 document, the Paris Agreement, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and associated targets and indicators, other relevant international processes (e.g. UNFCCC)

## The framework consists of:

- I. a **limited and non-exhaustive set of aggregated indicators** which are realistic, measurable, attributable and within the scope of SCP and the 10YFP programmes,
- II. associated **methodologies**,
- III. a **process** and
- IV. **tools** for use of the indicators through the different stages of monitoring and reporting.

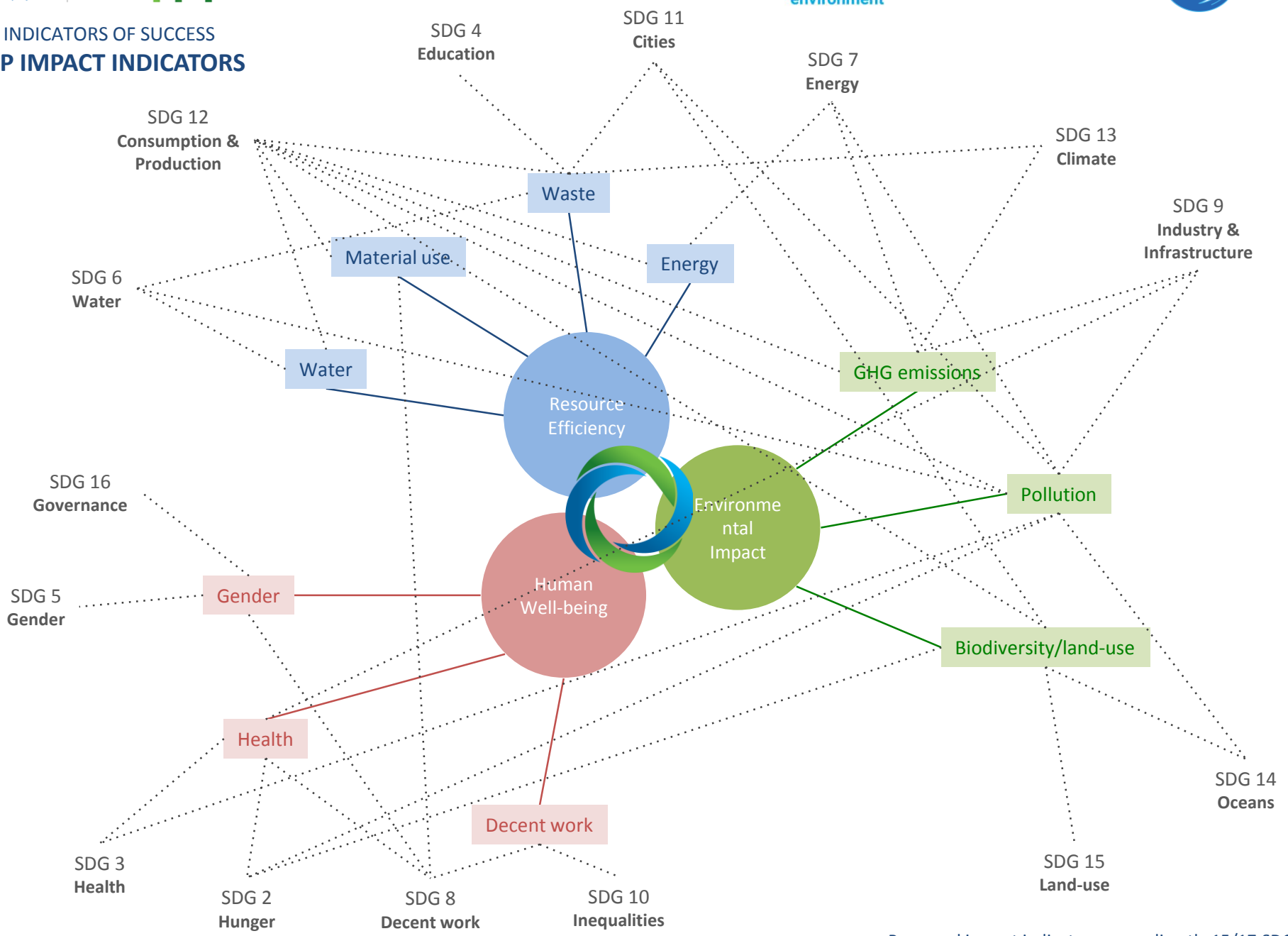

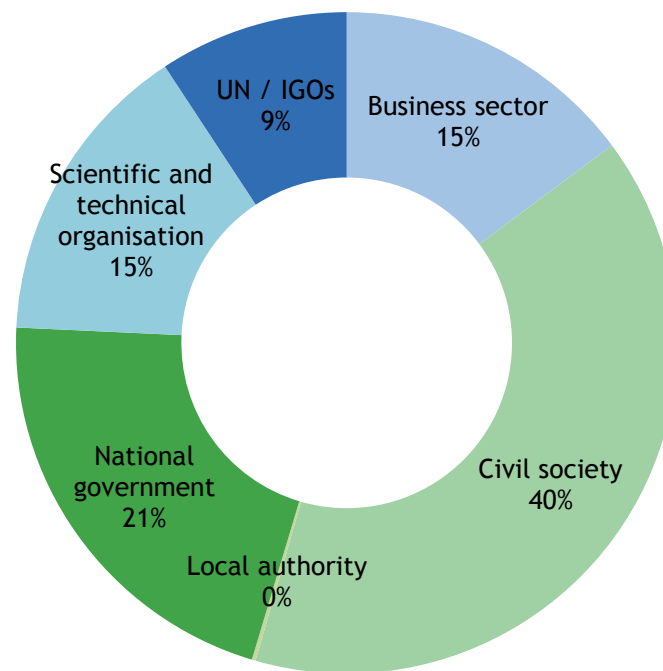
